Subject	Topic	Skills
	<u>ENGLISH</u> The Twits BFG	Pupils will develop their reading and writing skills through the theme of the Twits and BFG. Descriptive writing focusing on powerful adjectives and sentence structure to describe characters and settings. Daily spelling activity. Daily listening activity. Daily individual reading.
	<u>MATHEMATICS</u>	2D and 3D shapes. Consolidation of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division to support problem solving.
	<u>SCIENCE</u>	Our solar system. To recognise and describe all the planets. (Use of powerful adjectives)
	<u>HUMANITIES</u>	Religions around the world.
	<u>ART</u>	Study the work of Wassily Kandinsky (1866–1944) : A Russian-born painter generally credited as a pioneer of abstract art. Use a range of materials and mediums to produce abstract art.
	<u>COMPUTING</u>	Internet safety Fact file on Wassily Kandinsky
	<u>MUSIC</u>	Investigate any music used by Wassily Kandinsky relating to his art.
	<u>PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT</u>	Develop independence in everyday tasks. To include weekly catering lessons.

	<u>PHYSICAL EDUCATION</u>	Athletics To explore running, jumping and throwing activities.
	<u>PERSONAL, SOCIAL, HEALTH AND ECONOMIC</u>	Daily social time including games and discussions to support friendships, social skills and emotional regulation.
